- Contact the Labour Council to arrange for an accessible parking spot if required. (A valid MTO accessibility permit must be displayed along with an event pass.)

- Dispose of all waste before leaving – you must take your garbage and recyclables to the central waste management bin/dumpster on site.
- No smoking is permitted in the park
- No inflatable beer or alcohol related props
